

Definition

- + What is separating fact and opinion?
- + It is to decide if what you read is true or the writer's personal opinion.



How to separate fact and opinion

- Don't believe everything you read.
- Look for words connected with facts: evidence, fact, prove, certain, positive, sure.
- Look for words connected with opinions: think, believe, claim, perhaps, suggest, possible, may, might, could.



Example

Fact: No one can say that is not.

Phnom Penh is the capital city of < Cambodia.

Opinion: Some

Tennis is the best sport in the world. people may disagree



Think

- What is the general topic of the text?
- What is the subject of each paragraph?
- What are the important words?
